

Valuable Items

POLICY

Rationale

- It is acknowledged that in exceptional circumstances children may need to bring mobile phones or other valuable items to school
- These items may be distracting in class
- These items may represent an invitation for theft

Aims

- To minimise distractions to class
- To decrease the temptation for theft

Implementation

- All valuable items brought to school are at the risk of the individual child and Derrimut Primary School accepts no responsibility
- Children must have signed permission from parents for each item brought to school
- All valuable items brought to school by children must be taken to the office before school
- All items, if electronic, must be turned off
- Children must sign valuable items in to office and out from office at the end of the day
- It is the responsibility of children to pick up their own belongings at the end of each day
- Items will be locked up.
- Derrimut Primary School will not be responsible for any items which are not signed into the office

Evaluation:

- This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three-year review cycle.
