## Minor Behaviours - Teacher Managed

- Digital Safety**
- Playing games during learning time
  - Sharing/viewing inappropriate content online
  - Taking photos/videos of others without consent
- Disruption**
- Calling out or interrupting
  - Talking to others (e.g. when teacher is talking)
  - Roaming (e.g. unnecessary moving during learning time)
  - Yelling in quiet areas (e.g. Sensory Garden)
  - Being unsafe (e.g. entering and exiting, on equipment)
- Non Compliance**
- Ignoring instructions
  - Refusing to complete work
  - Being out of uniform
  - Walking off whilst being spoken to
  - Not following the rules of the game
  - Playing in outbound areas (fence line, toilets etc.)
- Physical**
- Shoving and pushing
  - Play fighting/contact game
  - Touching others
- Property Misuse**
- Reversible low level damage of property (e.g. drawing on a table)
  - Using/taking other people's property without permission
  - Using an item not for its intended purpose (e.g. throwing hats)
  - Littering
- Psychological**
- Excluding others
  - Imitating others
- Truancy**
- Coming/returning to class late (e.g. ignoring the bell and continuing to play)
  - Roaming during learning time (e.g. taking too long to return from the toilet)
  - Playing in the wrong area (e.g. along the fence line)
- Verbal**
- Speaking unkindly to others or about others
  - Lying
  - Swearing (non-targeted)
  - Answering/talking back

## Major Behaviours - Leadership Managed

- Digital Safety**
- Direct verbal or indirect bullying behaviours using digital technologies
  - Posting or looking at inappropriate content on digital devices
  - Not telling an adult if we see something unsafe online
  - Using or sharing other people's information online
  - Sharing/viewing explicit inappropriate content online
- Physical**
- Physical contact (e.g. hitting, punching, kicking)
- Property Damage**
- Deliberate damage of personal or school property
  - Graffiti or vandalism
  - Possession of weapon or illicit item
- Psychological**
- Threatening or intentionally humiliating others
- Theft**
- Of school, teacher or student property
- Truancy**
- Leaving classroom or school grounds without permission
- Verbal**
- Insults, swearing, homophobic, racist or sexual remarks about or to others (GBV - Gender Based Violence)
  - Threatening to harm others
